### Design Activity #2

- Part 1: Develop a background story for your game
  - Provide the text description
  - Explain what type(s) of stories will be used in your game
  - Identify which part of the story will be told and how e.g. cutscenes, creating characters to interact with, exploratory elements, branching story choices
  - Which way of storytelling feels most satisfying and why? List pros and cons for at least 2 alternatives

## Design Activity #2 (cont.)

- Part 2: Develop goals
- Clearly identify at least:
  - 2 short term goals
  - 2 long term goals

#### Among these, you must have:

- 1 set of overlapping goals
- 1 set of mutually exclusive goals
- Describe what user has to accomplish to attain each goal
- Identify multiple ways of achieving each long term goal

# Design Activity #2 (cont.)

- Part 3: Character design
  - Create a main character and select a verb for it
  - What does your character look like?
  - How does the verb progress over time? How does this progression happen in your game?
  - What are other characters in the game (at least 2)?
  - What do these other characters look like? How do they interact with your main character?

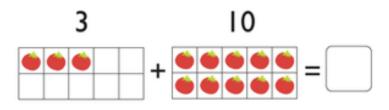
#### Things to Avoid

- Story and educational activity should be integrated and well-connected
  - Test: does game work if you substitute educational concept?
- Interesting storyline with common and competing goals enriches user experience
  - Test: can player make choices to achieves long term goal or choices that deviates from it?

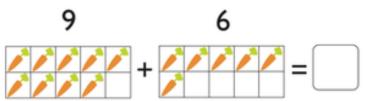
